Submission Guidelines:

To present individual papers: Submit an abstract of 500-800 words. Include complete contact information (name, affiliation, address, telephone number, and e-mail address) for each author, and designate a single contact author.

To present a complete session: A complete session should consist of three or four papers, with a discussant for each paper and a session chair. Provide a tentative session title. An abstract of 250-500 words is required for each paper. For each author, discussant, and the session chair provide complete contact information: name, affiliation, address, telephone number, and e-mail address. Designate one contact author for each paper. Also provide complete contact information for the session organizer.

There is no submission fee for proposals, but all presenters and non-presenters who attend the conference must register for the conference and pay the conference registration fee. The deadline for submissions is January 8. Final papers are due March 28.
